Students need to MEMORIZE and prepare the following solo. Mr. Jackson will play ALL parts while you perform the solo in your audition.

ALL LADIES should prepare the ALTO PART. (No Melody!)

GENTLEMEN have the choice of either preparing the BASS PART or TENOR PART.

Students will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Tone Quality (10 Points) *Placement of sound, projection, control*
- Intonation (10 Points) *Accuracy of pitches*
- Technique (10 Points) *Breathing, Body Alignment*
- Diction (10 Points) *Precise consonants, vowels*
- Interpretation (10 Points) *Facial expression, vocal expression*
