1. **Respect everyone around you, as well as yourself. To be treated like a mature and responsible individual, you have to be one.**
2. **Use Common Sense! (if you need help ask for it)**
3. **Always wear protective glasses when cutting material, or using tools that discharge projectiles (Nail Guns, Staple Guns).**
4. **A member of the directorial staff MUST be present when using any saws.**
5. **Don't operate any equipment for which you haven't been trained. (fly system, saws, lighting and sound equipment.)**
6. **Always wear appropriate clothing for being in the theatre. (Closed-toed shoes, no loose clothing or jewelry.)**
7. **Tools and material are NOT meant to be played with. Use them for their correct purpose.**
8. **Work areas need to be cleaned before the end of rehearsal. All equipment must be cleaned and replaced by the user after each use.**
9. **Headphones may not be worn without permission from a member of the directorial staff.**
10. **Report any accidents, minor injuries, or unsafe conditions to a member of the directorial staff.**
