"Mi Ze Hidlik" is a Chanuka song describing the lit candles and the great joy of the Jewish people who celebrate this festival each December. Chanuka literally means "dedication" and lasts eight days. On the first night of Chanuka a single candle is lit. A new one is added each subsequent evening. The feast was instituted in 165 B.C. by Judas Maccabeus and his brothers to commemorate the cleansing of the temple which had been desecrated by Antiochus Epiphanes, King of Syria, three years earlier.

This traditional Catalan carol is likely at least 400 years old, and there remains some discrepancy as to the meaning of the word "fum" throughout. In Catalan, the definition of "fum" is smoke, so it has been suggested that the carol continuously alludes to smoke seen rising from chimneys on Christmas Day. However, some say the intrinsic percussiveness of the word "fum" could serve simply to mark cadence points in a text that otherwise might become too breathless. – Howard Helvey

The Permian Basin String Quarter

Described by the Odessa American as "a precise and authoritative sound" **the Permian Basin String Quartet (PBSQ)** is the resident quartet of the Midland-Odessa Symphony & Chorale and is comprised of the principal string players of the orchestra. The quartet members have developed a loyal audience and a reputation as a leading ensemble in the Permian Basin. The PBSQ has made recent appearances in Midland, Odessa, Abilene, Alpine, San Angelo, Big Spring, Lubbock, and Hobbs, NM. In 2015, the PBSQ was the featured guest artist on the Abilene Christian University (ACU) Tour as the soloists on Short Stories by Joel Puckett as well as gave the Texas premiers of several works by ACU visiting composer Hyunjoo Lee. In 2013 the PBSQ appeared in the Abilene Philharmonic Nocturne series as well as the Church of the Heavenly Rest Chamber series. The PBSQ frequently appears with the San Angelo State University Choir, has given masterclasses in Mexico and Lubbock, TX as well as appeared with Chamber Music Amarillo. In addition to performance, the PBSQ is very dedicated to music education. The PBSQ gives educational concerts at elementary schools in the Permian Basin throughout the year. In addition, the PBSQ serves as section coaches for several high school orchestras in the Permian Basin as well as the University of Texas-Permian Basin (UTPB) University Orchestra. The PBSQ



has also partnered with UTPB as the faculty for the All-Region Summer Workshop as well as the Hartwick College Summer Festival in Oneonta, NY. Members of the PBSQ are on faculty at UTPB, ACU, Midland College and Odessa College as well as maintain private studios.
