Several weeks ago, the Chatfield Men's Choir had the privilege of attending the JeffCo Men's Choir Festival, an annual event that gathers the county's men for a day of music and "MAN Jokes!"

Each year, Ralston Valley High School brings in a guest director who leads over four hundred men in several group numbers; this year the mass choir performed "Till the Walls Come Tumblin' Down" (an African-American spiritual) and "Come All Ye Fair and Tender Ladies" (a ballad). While rehearsing these pieces, participants also got the chance to meet boys from other schools. This proves particularly important when considering high school choir is typically dominated by women; participating in a choir of more than four hundred men was a completely new experience for many first-timers, and refreshing for Men's Choir Fest veterans.

After a tasty lunch of pizza and juice, each high school choir performed individually. Chatfield represented its program well with a rousing rendition of "Sixteen Tons." Hopefully the Chatfield Men's Choir will be able to attend the event in future years because it provided a sense of camaraderie among choir men!
