This group will be traveling with 73 students and 12 Adults/Minor Guests. Craig Westwood will be the Tour Manager for the group and facilitate the tour and daily activities. Students will be provided with a detailed trifold itinerary with times at DIA on the morning of departure.

March 19 – Thursday (2 outbound flights)

GROUP #1 – DELTA AIRLINES

Outbound - Thursday, March 19, 2026 – Depart DEN on flight DL447 at 7:30am – Arrive New York/LaGuardia Airport at 1:16pm

DELTA AIRLINES CHECK-IN:

The designated meeting time at DIA is 5:00am.

The airport has ongoing construction, and many airlines are currently sharing the interior of DIA on level 5. Please follow these instructions for group check in:

Drop off on the West side – 6th level. Take the escalator downstairs and walk to the middle of the airport. Meet your Tour Manager, Craig Westwood, on the 5th level at the Delta Airlines counter. He will assist with the check-in for the group.

Each Delta Airlines flight will incur a \$35 first checked bag fee. This cannot be prepaid. Individuals will need to pay for their checked luggage with a credit/debit/prepaid card. The airline does not accept cash. Attach the luggage receipt to the back of your boarding pass.

Students will gather inside in their assigned groups before proceeding to security.

GROUP #2 - UNITED AIRLINES

***Outbound - Thursday, March 19, 2026 – Depart DEN on flight UA 1442 at 8:15am
– Arrive New York/LaGuardia Airport at 1:58pm***

UNITED AIRLINES CHECK-IN:

The designated meeting time at DIA is 5:45am.

Drop off on the West Side - 6th level (DEPARTURES) – United - Door #608. Once inside, walk straight in past the wheelchair area and down on the right-hand side at positions 24 & 25 to meet one of our representatives, **Chase Arnold**. Please follow his instructions for check in.

Each United flight will incur a \$40 first checked bag fee. This cannot be prepaid. Individuals will need to pay for their checked luggage with a credit/debit/prepaid card. The airline does not accept cash. Attach the luggage receipt to the back of your boarding pass.

Students will gather inside in their assigned groups before proceeding to security.

SECURITY:

Groups will travel through the East or West Airport Security with their chaperones. If you bring a water bottle, it must be empty to pass through security (ice is okay). You can fill it on the other side. Have your Boarding Pass ready (and ID for adults) for the agent to review at TSA. You usually will not need to take your shoes off but should plan on removing your belt and jacket/hoodie. Empty your pockets and place everything (including your telephone) into plastic bins. Remain with your items to slide them onto the conveyer belt before passing through the security unit as directed by TSA Agents. Remove your items from the bins on the other side of security and move to the seating area to redress. Once you have completed that, and your chaperone group has reassembled, you can proceed to the gate. **Each chaperone group must be complete prior to boarding the train at DIA to the assigned gate.**

GATE/BOARDING/FLIGHT:

Everyone must locate the assigned gate noted on the boarding pass. If there is time, you can visit food vendors in the concourse, but make sure personal items are being watched. You must return to the gate at the specified time to regroup with your chaperones. **Gate assignments can change so stay aware.**

Your ticket will note a boarding zone and seat assignment. You will go to your assigned seat upon entering the UA or DL plane, place your carry-on in the overhead bin and place your personal item under the seat in front of you. Drinks and/or food can be carried onboard and consumed during the flight. Please note nonalcoholic beverages and a snack should be served onboard. Flight attendants will relay instructions regarding safety and use of electronics, to including placing your cell phone in “Airplane Mode”. **You may want to download the United or Delta Airlines App to access the entertainment on your phone or electronic device.** If the traveler belongs to the United Airlines or Delta Airlines mileage program, they can provide this

information to our office by March 1st (aitraveltours4@gmail.com) to have it added to the tickets. You can also contact Mileage program directly after the tour returns but make sure to retain the boarding passes for ticket information you will need to provide.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

- PRIVATE TRANSFERS:

The Tour Manager will coordinate the Academy Charter bus movements for the groups arriving and departing NYC. There will be one motorcoach to transfer each group to the hotel.

The tour manager will facilitate the hotel check-in process.

Breakfast (included) will be at Applejacks Diner (a ½ block walk from the hotel).

Visit Radio City Music Hall for a guided tour.

Lunch at own expense.

Attend a Broadway matinee (TBA).

Dinner at the Hard Rock Café.

Attend the Broadway musical “**The Great Gatsby**”.

Everyone returns to the hotel – Room Checks – Lights out!

March 22 – Sunday

Wake up – Dress according to the weather forecast.

Breakfast (included) will be at Applejacks Diner (a ½ block walk from the hotel).

Return Airlines

Arrive at LaGuardia Airport and unload the luggage per your Tour Manager’s instructions.

Your Tour Manager and Director’s will facilitate the group check-ins and travel to the assigned gates.

Checked luggage will incur a \$35 or \$40 checked bag fee that can be paid by credit, debit or airline gift card. Airlines do not accept cash. Each traveler will have an assigned boarding group and seat. Please utilize that seat for the duration of the flight unless instructed differently.

9:09pm – Both groups arrive at DIA. Gather inside the terminal before proceeding to baggage claim to meet parents and retrieve luggage.

**Be aware that baggage claim is on level 5 of DIA and is the public transport level. Private pick up can only be accessed on Level 4 of DIA.
